*Plastics Injection Molding Company to Invest \$1.3 Million, Create 45 New Jobs*

**NASHVILLE** – Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development Commissioner Bill Hagerty along with RCTENN officials announced today the company's plans to expand its Gallatin, Tenn. facility. The expansion represents a \$1.3 million investment by RCTENN and will create 45 new jobs in Sumner County.
