

NOTICE OF HIGHWAY DESIGN AND INFORMATION MEETING

The City of Gallatin, an equal opportunity affirmative action employer, will conduct a Highway Design Meeting on the 23rd day of August, 2012, at the Gallatin Civic Center, 210 Albert Gallatin Avenue, Gallatin, TN 37066 to discuss Albert Gallatin Avenue/Hatten Track Road Extension, from S.R. 109 to just East of S.R. 174 (Dobbins Pike), as shown on the general location map.

The purpose of the project is to provide a new and improved section of roadway between S.R. 109 and S.R. 174 (Dobbins Pike) at its intersection with Albert Gallatin Avenue. The proposed improvements generally follow North Water Avenue and Hatten Track Road, with a new roadway section extending from the west end of Hatten Track Road to S.R. 109. The improvements are approximately 1.8 miles long. The project includes two typical sections for the roadway; a 2-lane section with a 32' raised median, 2 @ 12' lanes, 8' shoulders/bicycle lanes and a ditch section from S.R. 109 to just west of Station Camp Creek. From Station Camp Creek to S.R. 174 (Dobbins Pike), a 5-lane section is proposed with 4 @ 12' lanes, and a 12' center left turn lane, with 4' shoulder/bicycle lanes, curb and gutter and 5' sidewalks.

This meeting will be held from 5:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. during which time there will be a presentation followed by a question and answer session. The public is invited to ask questions and make comments during the meeting. Project team representatives will be present to answer questions on any aspect of the project. The public is invited to review the displays anytime within the scheduled two hours.
