(Gallatin, TN) The City of Gallatin Economic Development Agency (GEDA) released its 2015 Growth Report today detailing results of the agency's efforts and their impact on the community.

The 28-page report includes information on job growth, estimated capital investments, a project pipeline, housing statistics, tax structures, education overview, work outreach, road projects, and more.

"The Gallatin EDA does not work in a vacuum," said James Fenton, Executive Director. "Every department in the City contributes to the work we do. Their collaboration is invaluable. This report is as much about their work as it is EDA's."

Ten new or existing companies added 1,761 jobs in Gallatin, as the report itemizes. At the time the report was printed, there were 17 prospects in the pipeline ranging from medical to manufacturing. Additionally, in the first three months of 2016, GEDA has received inquiries or site visits from several more prospects.

"GEDA is benefitting from the vision and planning of its City leaders," Fenton said. "The Council, Mayor, Planning Commission, GEDA Board, and Industrial Development Board – all those people are instrumental in Gallatin's success."
